

CEDAR VALLEY TRAILS PARTNERSHIP

2026 GRANT APPLICATION

The Cedar Valley Trails Partnership, a non-profit volunteer group advocating for the safe and enjoyable use of the Cedar Valley recreational trail system, invites applications for financial aid for projects that will further the Partnership's goals.

Eligible Projects

Cedar Valley Trails Partnership grants may be used as matching or primary funds for trail projects in Black Hawk and contiguous counties. Eligible projects include those that will:

- Expand or improve the recreational trail system.
- Maintain the trails to the highest obtainable safety, beauty, and utility standards.
- Promote the trail system as a recreational resource, vacation, and tourism destination.
- Educate trail users in trail etiquette and safe trail use.
- Planning or study projects and funding for operational staff costs are not eligible.

Minimum grant: \$500

Maximum grant: \$5,000

Application deadline: February 28, 2026

Announcement of grant awards: April, 2026

Recognition Stipulation

Any project funded partially or entirely by the Cedar Valley Trails Partnership must bear the words "Provided by the Cedar Valley Trails Partnership" or words to that effect. The Partnership shall have final approval of all media releases concerning this grant and of the recognition of this grant as a funding source for the project.

Grant Decisions

The Partnership prioritizes projects that provide long-term benefits to the Cedar Valley recreational trail system and its users. The Cedar Valley Trails Partnership board of directors votes on all requests for funds. Board members employed by or otherwise involved with the applicants shall abstain from the vote, though they may participate in the discussion of the applications. The Partnership will send written notice to all applicants informing them of the board's decision.
